Memory

Semantic Memory – a type of long-term memory involving the capacity to recall words, concepts, or numbers, which is essential for the use and understanding of language. They are indisputable nuggets of information not associated with personal experience.

Verbal Working Memory – temporarily storing verbal information such as letters, words/sentences when you read, numbers, or nameable objects.

Visual Working Memory - temporarily storing visual details of what you have seen. Visual working memory is used to describe both the storage and the manipulation of the information held in memory.

Auditory Working Memory – involves taking in the information presented orally, processing it, temporarily storing it.

Attention

Focused Attention – the ability to selectively concentrate on particular stimuli while ignoring irrelevant competing stimulus.

Auditory Attention – the ability to selectively concentrate on particular sounds, while ignoring irrelevant competing stimulus.

Visual Attention – the cognitive ability to visually concentrate on a particular part of important information from the environment.

Processing Speed

Reaction Time – refers to the amount of time that takes places between when we perceive something to when we respond to it.

Rapid Stimuli – refers to how quickly an stimuli many appear before it is gone or changed.

Executive Functions

Arithmetic Reasoning - Solving logical reasoning questions by performing various mathematical operations.

Planning – developing a well-thought-out strategy before starting a task.

Strategy - Taking current stimuli and making a decision to complete a task without being sure the outcome will be correct.

Inhibition and Interference - Cognitive inhibition refers to the mind's ability to tune out or block out stimuli that are irrelevant to the task/process at hand or to the mind's current state.

Deductive Reasoning - Deductive reasoning concludes by using information from two or more statements and draw a logically sound conclusion.



Language

Lexical Spelling - understanding how the written language represents the spoken language.

Lexical Meaning/Category – refers to the sense (or meaning) of a word as it appears in a dictionary.

Comprehension – the ability to understand the different elements of spoken or written language, like the meaning of words and how words are put together to form sentences.

Visual-Spatial Abilities

Pattern Recognition – the ability to match information received with information already stored in the brain.

Imagery – the that enables us to represent perceptual information in our minds in the absence of actual sensory input.

Visual-Spatial Exploration – the ability to understand, visualize and remember the positions of objects, their shapes, their spatial relations to one another and the movement they make to form new spatial relations.
